Thoughts from Pastor Mauri

Communication is the centerpiece of a healthy and functioning congregation. Whenever there is a breakdown, the business and ministry of the church begins to suffer. So it's important to keep everyone in the congregation up to speed on things going on in the family. Therefore. I want to take some time this month to share some thoughts on the state of the congregation in regards to financial giving.



In the last month or two, our treasurer has informed the session that things are tight financially. This relates to our irdship weekly giving, not to the investments that the church has. It has gotten

more difficult to see those dollars stretch when a lot of bills come due at the same time. I know it's not easy to talk about money in the church. It makes a lot of folks queasy. But it's important for the health and well being of the congregation.

Did you know that Jesus was not afraid to talk about it? He focuses on stewardship often in the gospels. Let me give you an example. In Mark 12, Jesus was teaching in the temple courts. He was popular with the people, but the religious leaders were out to arrest Him and kill Him. Some were sent to "catch Him in His words," hoping to find some fault they could use against Him. They approached Him with flattering words about integrity and His truthful teaching. Then they posed a question that they hoped would get Him into trouble with the Romans. "Is it right to pay the imperial tax to Caesar or not?" But Jesus

wasn't about to be trapped. He knew their hypocrisy.

He asked to see one of their coins, and He used it to teach about meeting our obligations to authorities (see also Romans 13), and recognizing that "what is God's" is a whole lot more. All that there is, is the Lord's—the "earth...and everything in it, the world, and all who live in it" (Psalm 24:1). That includes you and me and everyone else today, as well as in the past. We're all God's.

Thus we are called to give of who we are and what we have to God. It's stated this way in the ancient confession, the Heidelberg Catechism: "I belong—body and soul—to my faithful Savior Jesus Christ" (Q and A No. 1). And as God's Word puts it, "Offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God" (Romans 12:1). Giving God His due still means honest giving and, even though it's hard to swallow sometimes, taxpaying.

So I'd like to call on all of you to examine yourselves this month. Are you giving sacrificially to God and the work of His church? Are you able to give more? Please make this a big part of your prayers. God sure gave us His all in His Son Jesus Christ.




And, on June 23 during the worship service our own **Evelyn Jones** will be singing for us. Be sure to come hear her! We're sure you will be blessed.
